



Call Challenges for Europe

As part of the Challenges for Europe call, promoted by the Compagnia di San Paolo Foundation, Volkswagen Stiftung and Carlsberg Fondet, a total of 262 pre-proposals were received. Based on the outcome of the two-phase evaluation process carried out by an international review panel, 5 projects were considered eligible for funding, for a total amount of €4,624,403.
